The form should be used to disclose a wrongdoing.

Under section 10(1) of the Act, where a public servant reasonable believes that he or she has information that could show that a wrongdoing has been committed or is about to be committed or that could show that a public servant has been asked to commit a wrongdoing, the public servant may make a disclosure to:

- a) The designated officer for the government institution where the public servant is employed, or
- b) The Public interest Disclosure Commissioner
