The document below outlines how to set up a 3-to-6 way call from the IBC Soft Client desktop application.

The IBC Soft Client application has an option for 3-to-6 way conference calling, allowing you to speak to 3 to 6 participants without needing a special conference phone number. You can dial any type of phone (cell, IBC phone, Centrex phone) and phone number (private or public sector) from the IBC soft client. Please note that all IBC users have unlimited long distance calling in Canada and US.

When the host of call hangs up, the phone conversation will end for all participants. This method of calling is best used for smaller, impromptu calls.

The application can be accessed from any internet-connected computer with the software installed.





Navigate to the Webex desktop application. If you cannot locate the icon on your desktop, you can find the program by typing "IBC" into your search bar and log in using your IBC credentials.




Your username will always be your 10-digit phone number, followed by "@ibc.sasktel.com" (i.e. 3067875555@ibc.sasktel.com).

If you need to change or have forgotten your IBC password, please contact the Telephone Coordinator for your area. Only telephone coordinators can change or reset your IBC password.




There are two ways to dial a participant, by entering a phone number in the dial pad or selecting a contact from the phone directory.

Dial the first participant—From the dial pad.

Click the "Keypad" icon on the left side bar menu to navigate to the online dial pad. You can use your mouse or keyboard to enter in a telephone number.

While using the soft client on your computer, click the "audio" icon to dial.



### Dial the first participant—From the directory.


All IBC users in Government are searchable in the IBC directory.

Type a first name, last name, or telephone number into the search box to find a contact. Click

on phone icon next to the person you wish to call.






Once a call is made, a variety of call management options will appear in the tool bar at the bottom of the screen.

After your first participant has answered your call, select the Conference button to add the next participant.


The first caller will be put on hold once you selected.






In the Add a Person pop up box, enter the phone number of your next participant.

Or you may also search for contacts in the My Contacts and Directory lists. The directory lists all IBC users in Government.




The document below outlines how to set up a 3-to-6 way call from the IBC Soft Client desktop application.



Once the third participant answers the phone, you can merge the call to engage the conference call.




You can continue to add additional participants (host plus five others maximum) by selecting the Conference button.



Then in the Add a Person pop up dial or search the phone number of next participant. After they answer the same screen from above will appear click merge again, this will join all participatants.
