The Ecological Management Specialist serves as a primary contact within the administrative areas for the petroleum, natural gas and mineral exploration industries which include individual companies, consultants, industry associations, First Nations or Métis people, other government ministries, individuals and interest groups.

The position requires energetic, knowledgeable individuals with the demonstrated ability to establish successful working relationships with various internal and external stakeholders and bring demonstrated working knowledge and experience within these industries to the role.

The successful candidate must thrive in a high workload volume atmosphere. This position also serves as the primary contact for the administrative area for requests to use, purchase or lease Crown resource lands.
