#### **Key Responsibilities of position:**

The positions are located in Regina, and the ability to travel is a required component in this position. The successful candidate will have excellent interpersonal skills in order to build effective working relationships. You will have knowledge of continuing care health programs (long-term care, home care and palliative care), services and structures, as well as a good understanding of the current and emerging issues in these areas. You will have experience in policy development, applying research methodologies, statistical analysis programming, planning and evaluation. You will have the ability to build collaborative relationships within the Ministry of Health, other human services ministries and key stakeholders. You will have a demonstrated ability to manage projects, participate in committees and employ leadership strategies to motivate staff and project teams. You will have an understanding of the principles of program development, implementation and evaluation, as well as principles of community development and government processes.
