Qualifications: Hold an Aircraft Maintenance Engineer License with an M1, M2, S, or E rating. Possess a valid Saskatchewan Driver's License (Class 5 or equivalent). Key Responsibilities: Perform periodic inspections on airframes, engines, and systems across a fleet of 17 firefighting aircraft, including CL-215T, CV 580A, Twin Commanders, and DHC Dash8-400 Series. Assess deficiencies in airframe, engine, electrical, hydraulic, and instrumentation/avionics systems. Repair or replace deficient components in accordance with Transport Canada approval standards. Skills & Requirements: Knowledge of CARS, FAA regulations, and Transport Canada Airworthiness Directives. Ability to maintain accurate aircraft logbooks and diagnose issues through testing. Travel and work an altered fire season schedule (10 days on / 5 days off) is mandatory.
