As an Environmental Protection Officer in the Environmental Protection Branch, you will be responsible for:

- Reviewing and commenting on all required document submissions from municipal, industrial and mining operations including those for the management of environmentally impacted sites;
- Performing environmental inspections to ensure compliance with provincial legislation, the Environmental Code, regulations and approvals;
- Investigating spills of hazardous substances, and waste dangerous goods and approve clean up and remediation at assigned facilities;
- Developing the Province's environmental policies and regulations regarding municipal, industrial and mining operations and their inherent environmental concerns; and Responding to public inquiries or complaints.
