Key Responsibilities of position:

Supervising staff through scheduling, training, coaching, and managing daily workflows, while ensuring operational goals are met.

The successful candidate will respond professionally and courteously to public inquiries, and use sound judgment to identify problems, assess options, and determine appropriate courses of action. You will guide and perform in a wide range of maintenance and repair activities involving buildings, grounds, and trail networks.

Duties include operating light to heavy equipment such as trucks, mowers, snowmobiles, UTVs/ATVs, chainsaws, brush cutters, rototillers, tractors with loaders, skid steers, gravel trucks, and various power tools. The role also involves hauling equipment over 10,000 lbs and requires a valid driver's license, with willingness to obtain a Class G Endorsement. You will perform janitorial and sanitation duties, including garbage and debris removal as part of regular site operations.

The position requires frequent lifting, carrying and moving supplies and equipment.

The successful candidate will have knowledge and experience in building and/or park maintenance, use of common hand tools, safe equipment operation, and basic cleaning and sanitation practices. A strong understanding of OH&S, WHMIS, TDG, and Public Health Regulations is required, along with a commitment to risk management and workplace safety.

This role requires the ability to work independently or collaboratively as part of a team and the flexibility to work a variety of shifts as operational needs require.

You will have knowledge of:

- Staff supervision and basic human resource principles
- Safe equipment and building operation, maintenance and minor repair.
- Power Mobile Equipment - Light to heavy equipment operations.
- Basic cleaning methods (materials, equipment and methods commonly used in housekeeping/janitorial and sanitation activities).
