This document outlines the Mobile App Store Standard as a component of the Digital Public Services Policy. These standards inform Government of Saskatchewan service design for public-facing digital services.

Background

The Government of Saskatchewan (GoS) provides citizens with mobile applications ('apps') available for smartphones and other mobile devices. GoS has a developer account in the Apple Store and Android Play Store. This provides a central location for all GoS apps to reside within.

Standard Framework

Providing mobile apps within the GoS developer account increases user trust and confidence in the available applications.

Government of Saskatchewan App Store

All mobile apps must be published through the Government of Saskatchewan Apple and Android app stores:

- Apple App Store Government of Saskatchewan
- Google Play Government of Saskatchewan

Government of Saskatchewan App Branding

All digital brand standards must be incorporated following the GoS <u>Visual Identity Guidelines</u> and approval by the Executive Council Brand.
